



Ocean-Side Spa

WITH A SHARED love of sailing, this Boston couple was right at home in their high-rise condo thanks to its gorgeous ocean views. Desiring a bath retreat with a clean, modern design as beautiful as the vista outside, they hired Anna Orfanides and Mariette Barsoum of Divine Kitchens for a full gut and remodel.

The designers' biggest challenge was delivering everything on the owners' wish list. Topping that list: his-and-hers vanities at separate heights since the husband is 6-feet tall and the wife is 5-feet tall. However, the bathroom's current narrow floor plan did not allow for this. Their solution was using the space from an extra closet abutting the bathroom to create a space specific for the wife with storage and a makeup area. Running plumbing from another closet even allowed them to incorporate a sink.

Also freeing up space was the removal of an oversized Jacuzzi tub they never used—one of two tubs in the original design. In its place, Orfanides and Barsoum incorporated a large shower with all the comforts of a spa, such as a rain showerhead and body sprays. The shower's scene-stealer, though, is its linear drain with the blue LED water-activated lighting—the perfect complement for this ocean-side spa. *Learn more about this designer at www.divinekitchens.com.*
