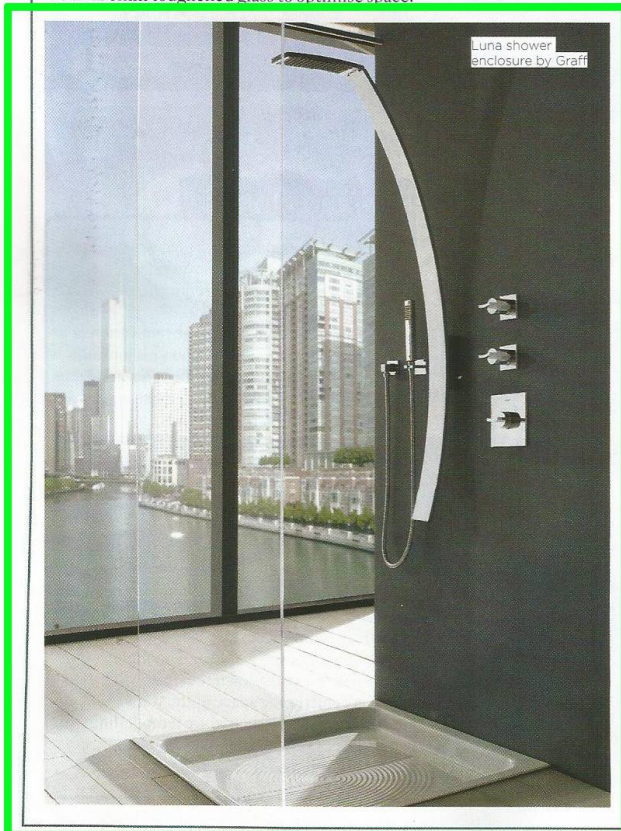

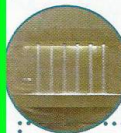

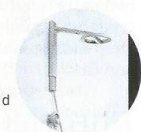
Axor Lamp Shower by Nendo, an overhead shower with built-in lights, comes in two versions: ceiling-mounted and wall-mounted
